Key Instructions:-

We are not charging any registration fee for the hackathon, but as our college campus is far from the main city (Quality Food is not available nearby), we are charging a nominal fee for food and refreshments for better experience of the teams (which will be compulsory).

Food and Refreshment Fees for the Team : ₹ 150/- per member(early-bird access), after 23/02/2025 Fees for the Team : ₹ 800/- per Team.(Non-Refundable)

For your own convenience, bring an extension board with you.

Platform:

All participants are required to register and submit their projects through the designated hackathon platform <u>Devfolio</u>

Project Submission:

Projects must be submitted by the designated deadline on the $01^{\rm st}$ March **ON SPOT.**

Submissions should include a detailed description of the project, code repository link (if applicable), and any additional document or resources.

Judging Criteria:

Projects will be evaluated based on creativity, technical complexity, functionality, and potential impact.

Judges will consider factors such as innovation, usability, scalability, and code quality.

Additional points may be awarded for projects that address specific challenge statements provided by the organisers.

Team Composition:

Teams can consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 members. Participants are encouraged to form diverse teams with a mix of technical skills and backgrounds.

How to get your team accepted in HackTheSpring :

- Submit your team application for review in devfolio.
- Our team will reach out to your lead out for the verification process and a payment link for the food as mentioned above, which will be compulsory for everyone to pay.
- After your payment gets received your team will be accepted in 24 hours, and you can join the hackathon offline at the venue displayed on devfolio.

Prizes:

FIRST	PRIZE 🥇	Rs.	9000/-

Prizes will be awarded to top-performing teams based on the judging criteria.

Prize categories and details will be announced closer to the event date.
