Judging Criteria:

Projects will be evaluated based on creativity, technical complexity, functionality, and potential impact.
Judges will consider factors such as Functionality, Innovation, Design, Usability, Documentation, Build quality
Additional points may be awarded for projects that address reliability, sustainability and considering real-world problems.

Team Composition:

Teams can consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 members.
Participants are encouraged to form diverse teams with a mix of technical skills and backgrounds.

Prizes:

FIRST PRIZE 🏆	Rs. 5000/-
SECOND PRIZE 🥈	Rs. 3000/-
THIRD PRIZE 🥉	Rs. 2000/-

Prizes will be awarded to top-performing teams based on the judging criteria.

Prize categories and details will be announced closer to the event date.
